

Team Scorekeeper Job Description
MVLAGS 2010 Season

Team Scorekeeper: (For divisions 8U and higher)

The scorekeeper plays a critical role in the game. They provide data to the coaches, statistics to the team and may be called on by the umpire to verify game information.

Each team keeps a scorebook but the **Home** team's scorekeeper is the official scorekeeper for that game and is responsible for turning in a GAME SUMMARY FORM (Rules/Game Section) at the end of each game. For 12U and 14U interleague games, the MVLAGS team is responsible for filling out and turning in the game summary form.

The scorekeeper is responsible for obtaining the lineups from both managers and should enter both in the scorebook.

The scorekeeper assists the manager with keeping track of the lineup by inning i.e. which player is up at the beginning of each inning.

At the end of the game, the home scorekeeper must get signatures from both managers and the umpire and then returns the summary sheet to the head scorekeeper in the Communications Box located next to the snack shack.

The Scorekeeper must attend all games or ensure that another trained scorekeeper is present at every game.
